









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natural wonders, including the Sun Temple, Gorakhnath Cave, Kalinjar Fort, Hanuman Dhara, Kamadh Kiri Parvat, Ram Ghat, and Kanta Nath Temple, each contributing to the state's historical and spiritual wealth.

Rani Jhansi Fort: The iconic Rani Jhansi Fort, also known as Jhansi Fort, is a symbol of valor and resistance. Perched atop a hill, this historical marvel stands as a testament to the indomitable spirit of Rani Lakshmi Bai, the Queen of Jhansi. The Shiva temple was also there in the fort which had the energy which all of us could feel even today. ### Mahoba: Hidden Gem of Uttar Pradesh



Furthermore, the government has initiated measures to protect the lake's biodiversity and water quality, recognizing





Devotees undertake a parikrama (circumambulation) of this hill to seek blessings and spiritual solace. The hill is dotted with temples and ashrams, making it a significant pilgrimage destination in Uttar Pradesh.

Ram Ghat and Kanta Nath Temple: Ram Ghat, located on the banks of the river Yamuna in Mathura, is a sacred bathing spot for pilgrims. It is believed to be the place where Lord Krishna bathed after killing the demon Kansa. Nearby, the Kanta Nath Temple stands as an architectural marvel, dedicated to Lord Shiva. The temple's unique design and intricate carvings make it a must-visit for tourists and devotees alike. The serene ambiance of Ram Ghat and the spiritual aura of Kanta Nath Temple create a peaceful atmosphere for reflection and worship.

## Cultivating Resilience: A Mission to Restore Traditional Millet Farming in the Kanha Landscape

anha Tiger Reserve, a beautiful Sal Forest not only abodes majestic hard-ground swamp deer and the majestic Bengal tigers but also shelters the indigenous community of Baiga and Gond tribals. These forestdwelling people have been the guardians of biodiversity in Kanha for generations. Among their rich cultural traditions, the cultivation of millets, particularly Kodo and Kutki, has played a central role in their lives. However, in recent years, with the resettlement of these communities outside the protected area and various policy changes, the cultivation of nutritious millets within these communities has witnessed a significant decline, leading to a profound shift in their dietary and agricultural practices.

Historically, most tribal families dedicated a substantial portion of their acreage to the cultivation of millets. These hardy, drought-resistant grains thrived in the region's terrain. Millets like Kodo and Kutki provided the communities with a source of nutrition and sustenance. However, as time progressed, with the introduction and promotion of High-Yielding Variety (HYV) paddy, many farmers transitioned to paddy cultivation, relegating millets to a few remaining fields.

Dhimrin Bai, a member of a Baiga Community re-settled on the periphery of the Kanha's core area, explains, "Most of our community's land is now transformed into paddy fields backed by state-run schemes and subsidies. Only a few degraded or barren lands adjacent to the forest remain suitable for millet cultivation but that too is at risk of wildlife conflicts."

The shift towards paddy cultivation

is driven by a multitude of factors, predominantly rooted in the labour-intensive and technologically lagging nature of millet harvesting and processing when compared to paddy cultivation. Dhimrin Bai adds that the laborious work of harvesting and processing falls on women. Consequently, the handful of farmers who





still grow millet now choose to sell their raw millet produce to middlemen instead of utilizing it for personal consumption. This transition is exacerbated by the lack of local processing mills for millet, rendering it more convenient for farmers to sell their produce rather than undertake the labour-intensive processing it demands. In contrast, paddy can be efficiently processed using readily available de-husking machines, enhancing

all. I go there to get my cultivated millets processed for household consumption, and I encourage others to do the same, either to consume or sell directly to EFF or external buyers."

Despite these efforts, several challenges persist. Community adaptation to consuming millet remains a hurdle, as habits formed over decades are hard to change. Finding levelled and barren land

its appeal. Furthermore, wildlife conflict has restricted the availability of suitable land for millet farming, as numerous arid or uncultivated areas are situated adjacent to forested regions, adding to the challenges. Additionally, the lower yield nature of millet compared to paddy, coupled with a preference for quantity over quality among these farmers, poses sustainability challenges for smaller families. Moreover, the absence of a local market for processed millets further discourages their cultivation.

Dhimrin Bai emphasizes, "Our community is grappling with a range of emerging health challenges, notably diabetes stemming from increased rice consumption, as well as the concerning impact on our children's health due to inadequate nutrition. The resurgence of millets is imperative to address these issues."

Recognizing the plight of the indigenous communities and aligning with the United Nations' Year of Millet initiative, a local organisation named Earth Focus Foundation decided to take action to revive millet cultivation. Their initial strategy included providing millet seeds to farmers, protecting their fields from wildlife through the installation of community-maintained chain-link fences, and facilitating a fixed and rightful selling price of millets for the farmers. Additionally, they actively lobbied the district administration to introduce millet-based meals in schools, hostels, and local lodges and resorts to promote local sales and consumption.

Dhimrin Bai enthusiastically shares, "EFF has also established a local millet processing mill on their campus, open to





As a responsible developer, we realized early on that sustainability is no longer enough. That is why we made the decision to always aim beyond protection, to enhancement – to having a positive effect on the environment and local communities.

We are developing two luxury destinations, which we believe are the most ambitious regenerative tourism destinations in the world today: The Red Sea and Amaala. We ensure that every decision we make

prioritizes the preservation of nature and where possible seeks to enhance it.

Before a shovel hit the ground, we sent in scientists to catalogue and assess the stunning biodiversity of the Saudi Arabian Red Sea coastline. Based on what they learned through a large-scale Marine Spatial Planning (MSP) exercise, we decided to develop just 22 of more than 90 islands and to leave the rest untouched. It is this MSP exercise that led us to set a target of achieving a 30% net conservation benefit to the area by 2040 – a goal we also applied to Amaala.

We also made the decision early on to

power our destinations by 100% renewable energy. We are completely off grid and building the world's largest battery storage facility to ensure The Red Sea is powered by sunlight, day and night. We recently marked a milestone moment when we completed the installation of 760,000 photovoltaic panels across five solar farms which will power Phase One of The Red Sea.

From vehicles to boats to aircraft, our mobility network will be 100% electric or powered by hydrogen too. We have partnered with ZeroAvia to collaborate on the development of seaplanes that utilize

hydrogen fuel cells for power. We are also currently trialing Partanna's carbon negative concrete pavers at our Landscape Nursery. This innovative technology not only avoids carbon emissions but naturally removes it from the atmosphere.

We are showing others what is possible, and we hope to inspire them to join us in the transition to regenerative tourism.

How is Red Sea Global contributing to community upliftment? With people and planet as our focus, we are actively engaged in various initiatives that contribute to uplifting our local communities. For instance, we proudly supported the creation of Souq Amerah, allowing local artisans and food producers in Umluj to sell locally-sourced foods, merchandise, crafts and other

food cooperative comprising 200 farmers, facilitating their access to new markets and ensuring fair prices for their crops.

We are committed to creating new opportunities for the Kingdom and its people, especially young people. We've launched a
